## Moggill Creek Catchment Group Photography Competition 2022

## Terms and conditions of entry – Digital Young Persons category (Grade 1–6)

- 1. Please read the competition rules carefully. Entries not conforming to the rules will not be eligible for prizes.
- The entries will be judged on how well they meet the category criteria as well as
  technical merit and composition. Photographs of non-native plants and animals will not
  be eligible for prizes. If you are in any doubt, just contact MCCG and we will provide
  guidance.
- 3. The competition judge acts totally independently.
- 4. Photographs must be no greater than 1000 pixels and have a maximum file size of 1 MB.
- 5. Each entrant can enter a maximum of 2 photographs, and these photographs must be of different subjects.
- 6. Entries should be single photographs only (no collages).
- 7. Photographs must have been taken in the last 12 months and within one of the Brisbane or Ipswich catchment areas. You may be asked to provide information on where and when the photograph was taken.
- 8. No previously submitted photograph will be accepted.
- 9. Photographs can be either colour or black and white. Only manipulation to enhance the print quality may be undertaken (i.e. elements of photographs should not be removed, added or colours substantially changed).
- 10. Photographs must be the bona fide work of the entrant.
- 11. The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 12. The photographer retains all copyright to the photographs entered, but by entering agrees to allow photographs to be uploaded to the MCCG Facebook page and MCCG Instagram page (the photographer will be credited).
- 13. Winning entries will be printed (by the MCCG) and will be on display alongside the open entries at Kenmore Village.
